This will acknowledge receipt of the returns of the referendum election held in Rockdale County on December 15, 1965, on the question to increase Rockdale County school tax millage from twenty (20) mills not to exceed thirty(30) mills.

From the consolidated returns it appears that 367 votes were cast in favor of the question; and 247 votes were cast against. These results are being certified to the Governor today.
