## Newton Sound Factory performs for United Nations

t was anything but a normal Monday morning for "The Newton Sound Factory."

It was the United Nations' first con- ference on United States soil outside of New York with leaders from over 190 nations in attendance.
Newton High's director of bands, Ja-" son Smith said "words can't describe" the experience.
"It didn't get real until we walked into the exhibit hall and we were just getting a quick lay of the land," Smith
said. "As we're walking through the exhibit hall and seeing the different names of the countries on the tables and walking all the way up to the front, t was really surreal."
According to a post from Newton County Schools' official Facebook page, Newton High was selected ahead of other high schools and uniersities in the area.
Newton's selection was due to Smith checking on one of the many emails and phone calls he receives for performance opportunities. A good portion of those contacts - which come from tour companies charging bands to perform - Smith said he will "ignore them."
But one email, in particular, caught Smith's attention.
In a nutshell, I didn't ignore the mail this time," Smith said laughing.
"She told me that she had a short list of bands that she was going to contact and we were on that list. She said I was the first one to reply. I said, 'You know what? You don't need to look any further. We are your group.'
The first contact came on Sept. 11, which caused Smith and other school officials to keep this opportunity a secret for a considerable amount of time. Around a month later, Smith shared the news with his students, but did not give the full details.

## Contention arises over tax assessor board appointment by evan newton

NEWTON COUNTY - Dec. 4's 4.5-hour board of commissioners meeting did not proceed without some contention, as commissioners deliberated over the appointment of Cynthia Butler to the tax assessor board.
It started just mere minutes after the meeting began when District 3 representative Alana Sanders made a motion to amend the agenda to allow the appointDistrict 3, replacing longtime member Charles Berry This came after Sanders says the item was taken off the agenda "per instructions of individuals in the county."
"Every six years, each commissioner has had the opportunity to appoint their individual from their district to the tax assessor board. But when it came to 2023 - when it was time for District 3 to make their appointment - the tax assessor board contacted our county attorney to deliberate to try to change what has been done over the years," Sanders said.
Sanders mentioned that, after pulling the minutes from previous meetings, every other appointment has been approved unanimously via the consent agenda without any discussion or consultation from the county attorney. She later claimed that a "perception thereof" may have played a part in why the item was aken off the agenda.
"If you look at the board - the board consists of five males. The only individual that is a female on that board is the secretary," Sanders said. "So are we stating that a female can not sit on the tax assessor board, the perception thereof?"
The motion made by Sanders to amend the agenda for the appointment of Butler to the tax assessor board was seconded by District 4 representative J.C. Henderson. However, the motion failed 3-2
District 1 representative Stan Edwards attempted to make a motion to allow discussion. Chairman Marcelo Banes stated that this item was "already on the agenda."
Butler spoke out during the citizen comment portion of the meeting to list her qualifications and to ask the board some questions.
"Do the commissioners in each district have the right to make their appointments to the district? Should a board member live in the district they represent? Is there any discrimination going up here in Newton County - why you dor is well qualified" But on the tax "I need to know if you are all being discrimi natory I need to know that from the board and I need natory. Before diving in, I want o emphasize that my intent is not to be disrespectful. Has this question been posed to all the Commis sioners who have made ap pointments? I can confirm pointments? I can confirm that it hasn't; typically, it's placed under the consent single agenda item with out discussion. This procedure has been in place since 1980 and remained unquestioned until it was my turn to make appointments upon joining the board in 2021
"Cynthia Butler willingly took on the responsibility of serving as my compre hensive plan appointment and I have witnessed her dedication and expertise firsthand. Beyond being fair and thorough in her approach, she is a com-munity-minded resident who genuinely cares about the well-being of our community In my view, this shouldn't even be a topic of discussion be a topic of discussion, especialCommissioners that other commissioners have never publicly stated their ratio nale for appointing current members to the board.
"I have consistently championed transparency and fairness as a public servant, driving positive change in our county. The current situation, where Mr. Charles Berry has served on the board for an impressive 24 years for an mpressive 24 years and re Dides in District 1, leaves District 3 without representation, while all other districts are duly repre-
sented, and District 1 has sented, and District
two representatives.
"It's noteworthy that, in the case of the six-year appointment for the Tax Assessor in 2021 for District 5, the appointment was made under the consent agenda with no discussion. As seen on Tuesday night's agenda, there were six appointments listed, and curiously, no one requested a discussion or sought clarification on the reasons behind these appointments."
Sanders was then asked why she felt that the item was taken off of the agenda, and responded with the following answer
"It appears that the re moval of the agenda item might be linked to the individual who has served for an impressive 24 years, having been appointed by our commissioners since 1999, and possibly not expressing a willingness to step down from the board. "The situation unfolded as follows: Upon being advised by the attorneys representing Newton County in 2021, I graciously called, Mr. Berry, as I was informed that he no longer resided in District 3. The attorneys facilitated the communication, and during our conversation, it seemed as though Mr. Berry may have been aware of the situation. He explicitly stated his decision to remain in his position until the term's end on December 31, 2023, and suggested that any further attempts to address the matter might lead to legal action.
"Considering the legal advice and the potential complications involved, our law firm recommended that I wait until 2023 to appoint a replacement for the position. This context sheds light on the decision to remove the agenda item and provides insight into the challenges faced in addressing the situation
"The appointment of the Board of Assessors position has been a recurring topic of interest, with individuals expressing curisity for years about my choice for this citizen-serving board. Mr. Berry, at an event in 2022, explicitly conveyed his reluctance to be replaced. Furthermore, the Chair of the Tax Assessor board active y sought meetings, both y sought meetings, both hrough messages and an n-person encounter at an event. This heightened in terest has raised concerns and prompted me to delve deeper into the underlying motivations. What do they not want to be discovered on this board?
"In 2021, our former county attorney advised against altering established processes within this board merely due to new commissioner or person ommissioner or personl agendas. The same occurrence happened when it was my turn to become Vice-Chair during my first year as a Commissioner. was provided with false information and learned that the policy relayed to me was inaccurate. I became the first commissionr ever to be on display to discuss my qualifications, subjecting myself to public scrutiny from my new col crutiny from my new coleagues on my first day on the job and a public vote a departure from the usual practice of handling such matters under the consent agenda.
"Interestingly, the widespread awareness of the appointment, even before it was officially on the agenda, raises questions about a, raises questions about disseminated. The county clerk is the individual who requests our appointments and places them on the agenda when the time comes. She informs us when terms are up and that we need to appoint, and she is responsible for placing appointments on he agenda She received Ms. Butler's appointment Montacted her, and invited ontacted her, and invited her to attend the meeting o be acknowledged. I only shared this information with the county clerk. This suggests a possible agen-da-driven motivation, especially if my appointment diverged from expectations or historical patterns
"It's crucial to acknowledge the perceptual lens through which these dynamics unfold. The fact namics unfold. The fact that Ms. Butler is a woman in what seems to be a male-dominated board could contribute to the complexities and resistance encountered in this process. The need for emains paramount, and I am committed to navigating these intricacies to ensure equitable representation."

Raffensperger renews push to ban noncitizens from voting


ATLANTA - Georgia Secretary of State Brad Raffensperger has renewed his call for a constitutional amendment prohibiting non-U.S. citizens from voting in elections in Georgia.
Raffensperger said a recent surge in illegal immigrants crossing the nation's southern border makes stopping non-citizens from voting more important than ever.
"Organizations like the Georgia Coalition for the People's Agenda are currently suing to end critical citizenship verification in our registration process, potentially exposing our elections to foreign interference and diluting the power of legally registered voters," he said.
"I'm calling on the General Assembly to take immediate action and pass a constitutional amendment ensuring that no liberal group can leverage the courts to add noncitizens to our voter rolls."
The issue last surfaced in the legislature during the 2022 session, when Democrats in the state Senate shot down a proposed constitutional amendment banning noncitizens from voting in Georgia elections. Democrats argued the legislation was unnecessary because such a prohibition already exists both in state law and in the Georgia Constitution.
About eight in 10 new Georgia voters apply for registration automatically when they get or update their driver's license. The state Department of Driver Services verifies citizenship status of license applicants.
Raffensperger conducted the first citizenship audit of Georgia's voter rolls in the state's history last year. The audit found 1,634 people who had tried to register to vote could not be verified as U.S. citizens.

Once again, it's the season of generosity. In addition to considering gifts for your loved
ones, you might want ones, you might want
to think about charitable gifts as well. But what should you know before making gifts to charities? And what impact might these gifts
have on your financial and ta situation?
First, you may want to create a gift budget by deciding just how much you will give to charitable organizations over the rest of the year.
Next, look closely at the groups to whom you wish to contribute. You can find many reputable charities, but some others may be less worthy of your support. One of the red flags of a questionable organization is the amount of mon ey it spends on administrative costs versus the amount that goes to its stated purpose. You can check on the spending pat terns of charitable groups, and find other valuable informa. tion about them, on the well-re garded Charity Navigator web site (charitynavigator.org) Once you've established a gift budget and are comfortable with the groups you choose to support, you might turn you thoughts to another key issue connected with charitable giving: tax benefits. A few years ago, changes in the tax laws resulted in a large increase in the standard deduction, which meant that many taxpayers found it more favorable not to itemize - and lost the ability to take charitable deductions. But

if you still do itemize your charitable gifts or contributions to tax-exempt groups those that qualify as 501(c)(3) organizations - can generally be deducted, up to 60 percent of your ad justed gross income although lower limits may apply, depend nd and the organization to which ou're contributing
Other more long-term ave nues also exist that combin charitable giving with poten haritable giving with poten ial tax benefits. One such possibility is a donor-advised fund, which allows you to make an irrevocable charitable contribution and receive an immediate tax deduction. You can give cash, but if you donate appreciated assets, such as stocks, your tax deduction would be the fair market value of the assets, up to 30 percent of the assets, up to 30 percen Plus, you would not incur the Plus, you would not incur the capital gains tax that would otherwise be due upon the sale of these assets.
Once you establish a do nor-advised fund, you have the flexibility to make charitable gifts over time, and you can contribute to the fund as often as you like
Another possible tax benefit from making charitable contributions could arrive when you start taking required min mum distributions, or RMDs from some of your retirement accounts, such as your traditional IRA and 401(k). These RMDs could be sizable - and

Coincidence No. 2: One morning - and I don't understood why to this day - something made me stop in front of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial that I had passed innumerable times on my daily runs. The Memorial contains the names of more than 58,000 servicemen and women who lost their lives in the Vietnam war. I walked over to the Memorial and looked straight at Maj. Paschal Boggs' name. Or, said another way, it jumped out at me. It was as though we were reconnecting some 20-plus years after our days at UGA. I still get goosebumps thinking about it.

I have written about Pat Boggs many times since then, won dering what happened to him. Through the power of the internet, I finally have my answer and coincidence No. 3. Democratic operatives have refined it. Republicans have wondered how it might affect their campaign, whether it might enhance or diminish the chances of Donald J. Trump returning to the White

From the White House
My fellow Americans,
I'm speaking to you from the White House, where so many important decisions in our history have been made and where so many await resolution in our own time. ATLANTA - Governor Brian P. Kemp today announced he has directed the Office of Planning and Budget to increase funding for the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council's (CJCC) Victim's grant using \$13.2 million in remaining American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for FY 2024. This follows significant cuts by the federal government to the crime victims fund, also known as Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) funds, despite a continued and heightened need for services as a result of increases in crime during and following the COVID-19 pan-

"Once again, the federal government is failing to deliver on promises made to the people of Georgia," Kemp said. "While the Biden administration has made the unfortunate decision to shortchange victims of violent crime, I'm proud that the state is able to step in, fund this vital program, and provide the support these individuals need."
Federal cuts to the program amount to a $\$ 19.8$ million reduction in funding for Georgia, compared to FY 2023. The additional funding provided by Governor Kemp's directive will provide continued assistance to over 200 non-profit organizations and local governments that offer
services to victims across the state which would've been negatively impacted. Those organizations include domestic violence shelters, domestic violence communi-ty-based programs, sexual assault centers, human trafficking programs, child advocacy centers, court appointed special advocates, culturally specific programs, hospital-based violence intervention programs, elder abuse programs and pros-ecution-based victim-witness assistance programs. ## Lidia's life: Celebrity chef Bastianich reflects on career with 'Culinary Jubilee'

Despite its ties to culture, religious practices, family economics, environmental concerns or political statements, food has a distinct way of bringing people together and encouraging conversation. Few people know this better than chef, author, restaurateur and TV personality Lidia Bastianich, whose catchphrase, "Tutti a tavola a mangiare" - or "Everyone to the table to eat," in English - has united people for the past 25 years. Best known for her countless shows and specials on public television during the past three decades, PBS releases an up-close-and-personal look into the life and work of the celebrated chef; " 25 Years with Lidia: A Culinary Jubilee" premieres Monday, Dec. 18.
In honor of this quarter-century milestone in her career, Bastianich welcomed the opportunity to speak with me about her childhood, her career, her own personal relationship to food and culture, and the moments that have meant the most to her throughout her journey thus far.

Caught in what was no doubt a rare moment at her home in Long Island, N.Y., Bastianich joins our video call clad in a vibrant pink sweater and scarf that provide a cheerful contrast to the white bookcases and potted palm behind her. Easy to see why North American audiences have been captivated by her for 25 years, Bastianich begins sharing memories of where her close kinship with food began.
"My grandmother used to make a soup [I loved]," Bastianich reminisces. "It's called yota, and it's unique to the region that I come from, [Pula, Istria], which is right on the border in [what] now is Croatia. ... It's a bean and pasta soup, but instead of the pasta, she would put in sauerkraut, and I loved it."

While this may be one of her most formative childhood food experiences, the association between food and family was just beginning for young Bastianich. Now 76 years old, the celebrity chef is quick to note that cooking, for her, "goes beyond just nourishing the body."
"It's [about] nurturing the person, the soul and the sentiments that come with it," Bastianich says. "Food is a communicator ... no matter what culture, if you sit down, and you eat each other's food, somehow doors open. You are accepting that person - through that food - for what they are."

And there is no denying that this Italian food ambassador knows about people. As PBS's " 25 Years with Lidia" shows through interviews with friends, family and colleagues of hers from throughout the years, Bastianich is an excellent communicator herself and values meaningful, deeply human connections above all else. To support this, the hour-long documentary features moments with fellow chef/restaurateurs Jacques Pepin ("Jacques Pépin Heart \& Soul"), Mary Sue Milliken ("Too Hot Tamales"), Elizabeth Falkner ("The Next Iron Chef") and Geoffrey Zakarian ("The Kitchen"). Perhaps the most surprising appearance in " 25 Years with Lidia," though, is that of celebrated actor and fellow Astorian Christopher Walken ("Pulp Fiction," 1994).
"I came [to the United States] at 12 years old, as an immigrant, and we lived in Astoria, Queens.
... Right across the street was Walkens' Bakery," explains Bastianich as she elaborates on the sense of community among immigrants to New York City at the time.
"Christopher [Walken]'s father was a German immigrant and he was a great baker, so [then] a 16 -year-old immigrant ... I applied ... and he took me on weekends," Bastianich says. "Christopher's job was to fill the jelly doughnuts with jelly and he used to press them and make a mess. We were friends, you know, the weekends we were there."
Beyond the interviews with Bastianich and those closest to her, " 25 Years with Lidia" also features "rare and never-before-seen video and photographs" from the now-established chef's journey to celebrity, including recollections of milestone moments such as her and her husband's critically acclaimed first restaurant, Buonavia, which opened in 1971, and her career-solidifying dinner with Julia Child and James Beard at her third restaurant, Felidia.
An emblematic figure of traditional Italian cooking in America, Bastianich is honored for her contribution to the culinary arts "with a celebratory meal, held at Lidia's family-owned restaurant, Becco, in Manhattan. Sharing in the special occasion are longtime friends Jacques Pépin, Christopher and Georgianne Walken, Geoffrey Zakarian, NYC restaurateur Angelo Vivolo, and Geoffrey Drummond, who was Julia Child's producer and helped Lidia get started in television" (per PBS).
