The honorable Mayor Jefferson Riley started the Work Session with a prayer and the pledge of allegiance and quickly moved into an update on the City Center project and the Harris building repairs. He said he talked to Ricky Bruce about the City Center Project and that it appears to be moving slow, but the rain has Stokes Construction backed up about a month. After Stokes Construction installs the underground utilities they will bring in dirt and begin paving the trail. Mayor Pro Tem Perry Lunsford suggested notifying the Super Seniors of the date when the City Center project will be completed so they can be thinking about an event. The honorable Mayor Jefferson Riley also shared that there are other people in and around the community, Mrs. Rosalind Howell and Mr. Sandy Moorehouse, interested in holding a fundraiser event for Newton Trail.

The mayor also reported that the roof repair on the Harris building is finished and the scuppers have water pouring out of them. Councilman Bryan Hale commented that there is still a heavy desk and square carpet tiles that needs to be placed in the dumpster before it is picked up.

An update on the new sheriff precinct was also given by the mayor. He said they have painted and put up sheet rock. They will also replace the front door and some windows. Councilman Bryan Hale said he was curious to see how this precinct was going to work. The Mayor Jefferson Riley said the sheriff told him it will be a full-time precinct.

The last couple announcements the mayor shared was that Councilman Bret Dunn's last official day was January 27, 2019 and that Cathy Farmer, the City's Administrative Assistant took a job with Gwinnett County and that there is a temp helping at City Hall right now.
