RESOLUTION TO APPROVE DISTRICT FOUR SPLOST PROJECTS

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2011, a SPLOST referendum was approved by the citizens of Newton County (SPLOST 2011). The approved SPLOST 2011 included \$545,000 for a multiuse community facility in District 4 and \$500,000 for recreation projects for District 4; and

WHEREAS, Newton County utilized \$500,000 in SPLOST 2011 funds to construct a multi-use Community Facility in the New Leaf Center; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to approve a plan for the expenditure of the recreation funds and the balance of the community facility funds; and

WHEREAS, as authorized by the Georgia Open Meetings Act, detailed information regarding a land acquisition budget was presented to the Board of Commissioners in executive session on April 1, 2014;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Newton County, Georgia, as follows:

- 1. Expenditure of SPLOST 2011 District 4 recreation funds is authorized for land acquisition, in accordance with the budget presented to the Board of Commissioners, for the following parks:
 - a. Nelson Heights Park
 - b. Victoria Station Park
 - c. Dinah Pace Park
 - d. Oxford Road Park
 - e. Trelawney/Fire Station No. 7 Park
 - f. Trailblazer Park

As land acquisition proceeds, funds may be reallocated among the various line items, if necessary, with the joint approval of the Chairman and the County Manager.

- 2. Expenditure of the balance of the SPLOST 2011 recreation funds is authorized for recreation improvements for the following parks:
 - a. Nelson Heights Park
 - b. Victoria Station Park
 - c. Dinah Pace Park
 - d. Oxford Road Park
 - e. Trelawney/Fire Station No. 7 Park
 - f. Trailblazer Park

A portion of the funds may be used to retain a professional recreation planner for advice as to the recommended improvements for each park site.

- 3. Expenditure of the balance of the SPLOST 2011 community facility funds is authorized for (1) facility improvements, and (2) audio-visual and computer equipment for the following community facilities:
 - a. Nelson Heights Community Center
 - b. Washington Street Community Center
 - c. Garden of Gethsemane Homeless Shelter
 - d. New Leaf Center
- 4. As authorized by Section 9(b) of the SPLOST 2011 Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax Intergovernmental Agreement, if the District 4 recreation projects are satisfactorily completed for less than \$500,000, the remaining unexpended funds shall be applied to the community facility budget.
